Chapter Membership Dues Increase Effective March 2 - Renew Early to Save

The Board of Trustees of DallasHR Management Association has approved a \$10.00 increase to all full price Professional, General and Associate Membership rates bringing the annual rate for DallasHR membership from \$115 to \$125. The increase will be effective on March 2, 2020. This increase of 8% is the first increase since 2014. This increase does not affect payment options such as Student, Retired, or In-Transition rates.
