2019 Platinum Excel Award Winning Chapter

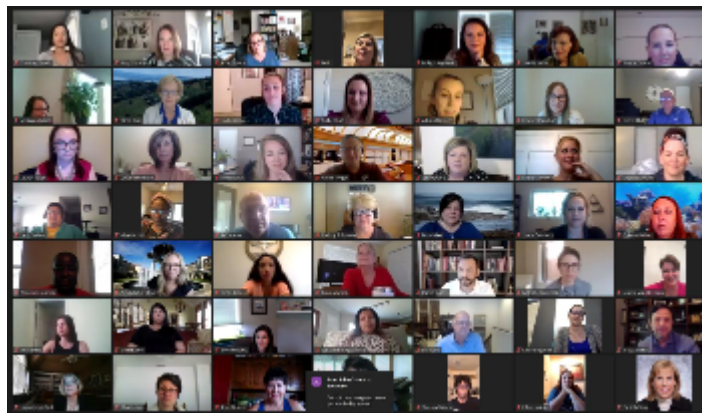
