Chapter Member Dues to Increase

The Board of Trustees have approved an increase for DallasHR membership dues in 2020. Effective March 2, 2020, all full price Professional, General and Associate Membership dues will increase by \$10.00. This is the first increase of member dues since 2014 and brings the annual rate from \$115 annually to \$125.00 annually.
